SMCC Financial Aid Basic Eligibility Criteria

To receive most types of federal and state aid at Southern Maine Community College, you must:

- Complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) annually as soon as possible after October 1;
 - Demonstrate financial need (for most programs);
 - Be a U.S. citizen or an eligible noncitizen;
 - Have a valid Social Security number (with the exception of students from the Republic of the Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, or the Republic of Palau);
 - Be enrolled or accepted for enrollment as a regular student in an eligible degree or certificate program;
 - Be enrolled at least half-time to be borrow a Federal Direct Loan;
 - Maintain satisfactory academic progress;
 - Sign the certification statement on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) form stating that you're not in default on a federal student loan, you do not owe money on a federal student grant, and you'll only use federal student aid for educational purposes;
 - Not be in default on a federal student loan and not owe money on a federal student grant;
 - Provide proof of high school completion, or a General Education Development (GED) certificate, or completed homeschooling at the secondary level;
 - Students with criminal convictions have limited eligibility for federal student aid.
