WHO

Employees in supervisory or management roles.

WHAT

This is a 16-hour training, usually presented in four classes running four hours each, or as a two-day bootcamp. Participants will learn:

- The core roles and responsibilities of a supervisor
- To identify and appreciate different temperaments
- Conflict management skills
- Effective communication techniques
- How to organize and prioritize work

WHEN/WHERE

The workforce development team will work with you to design a schedule that suits your needs. Classes can be held at Southern Maine Community College or at your location.

WHY

This training provides an opportunity to refresh existing skills and learn new ones so that you can be the most effective leader possible.
